CPA Audit Completed

The recently completed audit report and Financial Statements for 2012-2013 by Cagianut & Company, CPA is posted on the website (see the "Financial Statements Audit" post). You may also pick up a printed copy in the WRA office.

The opinion summary statement was: "In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Wilderness Rim Association as of June 30, 2013, and the results of its operations and its cash flows for the year then ended in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America."

Park Committee—Trees on Parade

Community volunteers have been actively working with our Park Co-Chairs to plant over one-hundred evergreen trees and sixty deciduous trees on community property throughout Wilderness Rim. Next, over sixty assorted shrubs will be added. All the new plants are native to the Pacific Northwest. Please watch out for the new baby trees.

Plans are in place to remove eight hazardous trees in the Park and greenbelt. These will be removed by professionals. We request that members stay clear of the these areas for safety's sake while the work is in progress.

Water Quality Concerns Q&A

This article contains excerpts from the "Water Quality Concerns Q&A" website post.

We have gone back to handling our own billing to reduce costs, to have control of our accounting as requested by our CPA, and to provide office services here in the community.

We anticipate saving at least \$10,000 per year by performing these tasks inhouse. For example, the expected savings on meter reading is \$4,300 per year.

We have hired a very capable office person, Suzanne Glazier, to do the billing and to handle member concerns and payments.

Denny Scott, our Water System Operator, has been working with Wil Chromey, our new meter reader. The meters have already been read twice with success. Our existing billing software license includes support for Suzanne.

We are resuming accounting—and "customer service" related functions. Sallal will continue to be our Water System Operator. They will continue to monitor water quality and to maintain the system. Our water quality will not be affected.
