### Easter Egg Hunt, Peep Roast and Firewise Event





# Bear Sightings and Washington Law



Please remember to secure your garbage cans, be watchful of your children, and do not approach or feed any bear. If you see a bear in Wilderness Rim, first call 911 to report the sighting and then contact the WRA Office. The 911 dispatcher will notify both the Sheriff's Department and the Department of Fish and Wildlife. Please review Washington State Law RCW 77.15.790 regarding attracting large wild carnivores.

### Water Rate Increase

WRA's Water Utility Committee (WUC) has reviewed the current WRA water consumption and sales figures, as well as the 2015 contract from Sallal Water Association. Sallal increased water cost by 6% and the maintenance contract by 20% for 2015. The WRA Board of Trustees voted to raise the base level minimum charge by \$1 and tiers by 7% each. The new rate increase is as follows:

Description	FORMER	NEW
Minimum Charge	33.00	34.00
Tier 1	2.95	3.16
Tier 2	3.26	3.49
Tier 3	4.42	4.73
Tier 4	5.92	6.33
Tier 5	11.09	11.87
Tier 6	22.15	23.70
