Annual Membership Meeting

The 2016 Annual Membership meeting was held on Saturday, September 19, 2016. Due to inclement weather the meeting was held indoors at the Chalet. While there was a modest turnout at the Chalet that day, online voting entries leading up to the meeting were ground-breaking. Over 200 ballots were cast, marking a historical amount of participation.

The minutes for the 2015 Annual Membership meeting, as well as the minutes for the 2016 Special Membership Meeting called on July 29, were approved. The proposed budget for 2016-2017 was also approved. Below are the results of the dues and assessment items on the ballot.

Dues and Assessments

HOA Dues

An assessment of \$13.33 per lot, per billing cycle was approved for a total of \$80 per year.

Security Patrol Assessment

An assessment of \$8 per lot per billing cycle was approved for a total of \$48 per year.

Advisory Committee
