Wildlife Safety

It is the season for bears in the area, so here are some tips on how to avoid attracting wildlife into the neighborhood:

- store all garbage in containers with tight fitting lids
- put out garbage only on the morning of pickup
- clean outdoor grills after use, including grease traps
- keep dogs on a leash; sometimes bears will follow off-leash dogs back
- pick fruits & berries as they ripen
- **Pro Tip!** Add a small amount of bleach or vinegar on top of your garbage when it's full to deter bears

Reminders

All dogs must be on leash if they are not in a contained space on your property, according to King County law. There have been a few incidents lately of unattended dogs running around the neighborhood and Cascade Park, and we want to make sure that both residents and animals are kept safe. Voice control and electronic shock collars do not meet the requirements of a leash. Please contact safety@wildernessrim.org if you have any questions.

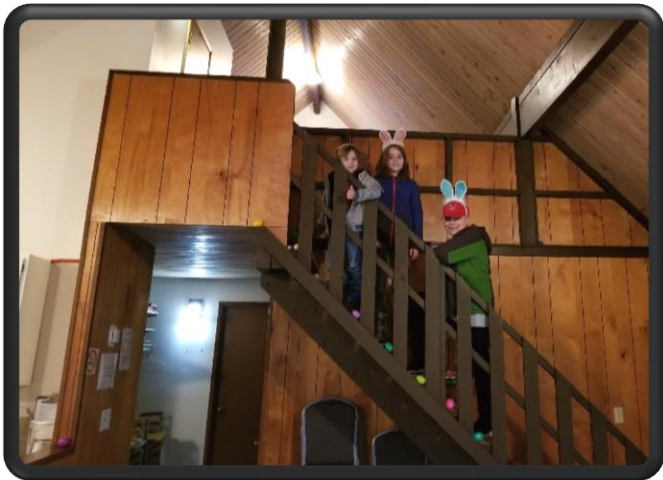
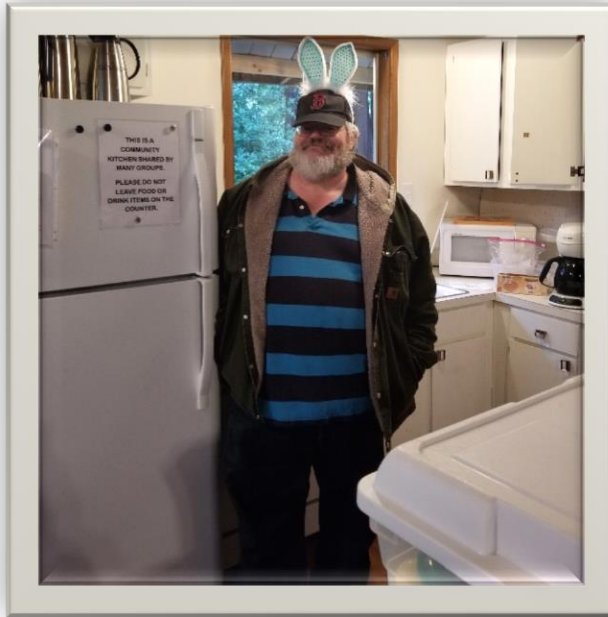
