Tenants and Landlords

The <u>WRA Rules and Regulations for the Water System</u> do not provide for billing tenants, however, tenant contact information is required to be provided to Agynbyte in case of emergencies (such as wildfire, water boil orders, etc.) or for community announcements. We Need Your Help Clearing Your Meter Box

During recent meter readings, it became evident that many member water meters are covered with vegetation that makes it difficult to access and read the meters. Please check your meter and make sure it is not covered with vegetation or any other obstructions. Meters are generally grouped in twos and found between your and your neighbor's houses. Meter Reader Position

Wilderness Rim is still in need of someone to read water meters throughout the community. This person must be willing to bend down to access all meters and clear out obstructions to take a reading, as well as have basic knowledge of Microsoft Excel. The typical time required is 25 hours every other month. The Association pays an hourly wage starting at \$20/hour for time spent and the reader must be at least 18 years of age.
