Bear Awareness

It's that time of year when bears are out of hibernation and can be seen around the neighborhood. Be sure to read the information provided with this newsletter about how you can help keep bears wild and away from the community.

How to avoid attracting bears:

- Store garbage inside a sturdy building, bearresistant container or enclosure.
- Never leave trash outside overnight.
- · Don't feed birds until bears hibernate.
- Cage or electric fence your chickens and livestock.
- Pick fruit before it ripens.
- Avoid planting fruits, berries, edible gardens near your home.
- Don't store food, pet food, beverages, bird seed, coolers, etc. on your porch or deck.
- Avoid feeding pets outside; the smells remain after the food is gone.
- Close and lock garage doors.
- Clean out your car. Don't leave behind anything with an odor.

This person must be willing to bend down to access all meters and clear out obstructions to take a reading, as well as basic knowledge of Microsoft Excel. The typical time required is 25 hours every other month. The Association pays an hourly wage starting at \$20/hour for time spent and the reader must be at least 18 years of age.
