Meter Reading Position Still Open

If you or someone you know is interested in reading water meters in Wilderness Rim, please email water@wildernessrim.org. This person must be willing to bend down to access all meters and clear out obstructions to take a reading, as well as basic knowledge of Microsoft Excel. The typical time required is 25 hours every other month. The Association pays an hourly wage starting at \$20/hour for time spent and the reader must be at least 18 years of age.
